- 2. CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS Your state does not have a charitable solicitations filing requirement. However, if you solicit funds in other states you may have filing requirements for those states. If you utilize a Professional Fundraising Counsel or Professional Fundraiser, please enquire with your Attorney General's Office for specific guidelines and regulations.
- 3. CORPORATE BIENNIAL REPORT

Biennially – Your state requires one every 2 years.
